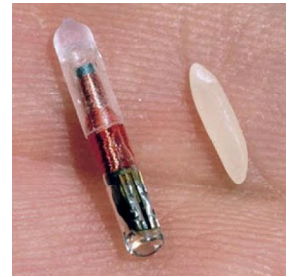
August Bank Holidays
